As many of you know, Dick is very involved in Club Visioning, so used Visioning as the topic. Many of you commented that you may focus on creating a vision which I'm sure Dick will be happy to hear. We also asked how the Alliance meeting could provide useful information. Here are some of the comments:

- Speakers: move beyond "first come, first serve"; identify great speakers that may not be "known"
- AGs: what training is being done for this group
- RCs: If the Coordinators/Teams are involved, how to help them with their pitch [RCs generally speak to Gov Corps and this is a different group].
- Identifying and sharing good curriculum methodologies
- Professional development for District Trainers
- PETS Board training tools
- Facilitator/Trainer training tools
- Identify PETS Events that have completely revised in the last 3 years and discuss their process.

Many of these topics are on the agenda. And we encourage all of you to bring your experiences (both good and challenging) to share, as well as any materials that you're using for training any of the various audiences. The MDPA is structured to provide multiple opportunities for interaction and discussion to learn from each other.
