Based on the commitments made to each other last July, we have scheduled the **Alliance meeting July 18-20, 2019** in Evanston to share ideas and continue our work in strengthening multi-district PETS worldwide.

Our fellowship time together will begin on Thursday evening at 8:00pm with a cash bar social in the Hilton Garden. Our meetings will begin at 9:00am on Friday at the RI headquarters — the dress is coat & tie — business attire. Our plans are to have informal dinners together on Friday night. The Saturday session (dress is casual — no ties) will conclude at 3:00pm.

Please note that this is a working meeting and representatives from each PETS organization are seated together. If your partner elects to come to the meeting with you, he or she may be seated in the back of the meeting room. Need 2019 rate here this decision based on space available.
